

"Anchors Aweigh" in Annapolis! with LifeLong Learning Society Tuesday – April 15, 2025

Annapolis is one of America's most historic cities, with many of its houses and public buildings dating back over two hundred years. In fact, Annapolis boasts more surviving Colonial buildings than anywhere in the country. Many exciting discoveries await your visit to this charming, historic seaport community.

Our arrival will bring us to the *United States Naval Academy* for their "Anchors Aweigh" Tour that focuses on the history of the USNA's beloved song, *Anchors Aweigh*. Learn the fascinating history of Charles Zimmerman, the Navy's beloved Music Director who composed the iconic song. A buffet lunch will be included at the *Naval Academy's Officers Club* followed by a visit to the *Academy Chapel* for a private organ recital by *Monte Maxwell* (pictured above). Mr. Maxwell is the USNA orchestra director, director of chapel music, and chapel organist, known and loved for his mastery of the organ. Enjoy his music and learn about the history behind the impressive organ. After this special performance, continue with a guided tour of the Academy, highlighting the historic buildings on the Yard. The tour ends at the *Visitor Center* for a chance to purchase a souvenir. *Please make sure to bring a photo I.D.*

This afternoon, board the coach for a *Guided Riding tour* of Annapolis, showcasing its grand Georgian Mansions, St. Johns College and the City Dock area. A stop will be made at the *World War II Memorial* which features 48 granite pillars and 22 panels etched with names of the 6,454 Marylanders killed in the war. Time and weather permitting, you'll have a chance to stretch your legs and explore the quaint downtown shopping area along the water.
