This 250-acre property is where Abraham Lincoln crafted some of the most pivotal decisions in U.S. history, including writing the Emancipation Proclamation. Immerse yourself in a guided tour of the home and explore the Visitor Education Center, filled with fascinating exhibits and videos. If the weather's right, take a leisurely 1.5-mile self-guided walk through the stunning grounds, making stops at nine historic landmarks. This action-packed day promises history, beauty, and unforgettable moments—don't miss it!
