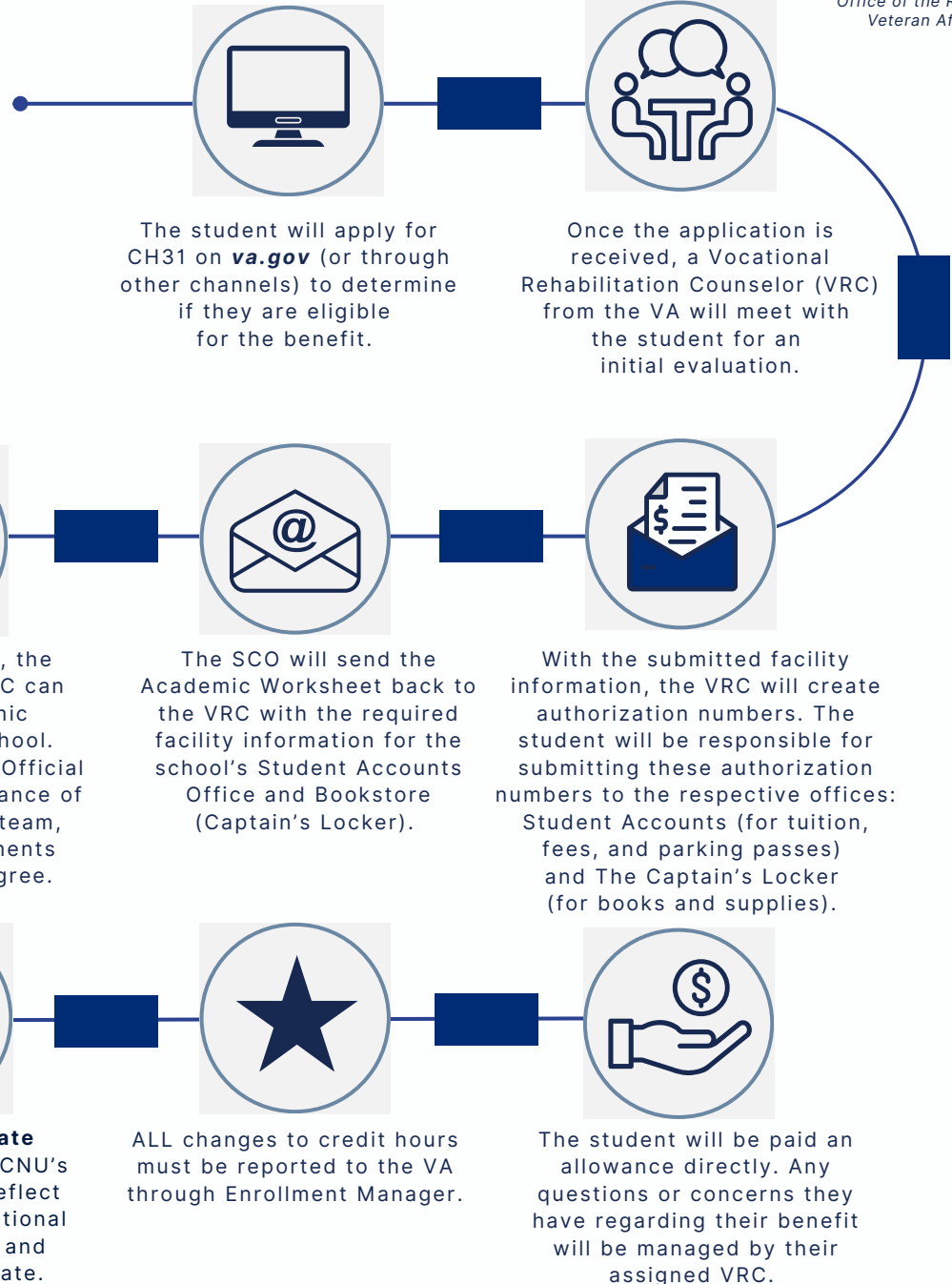


CHAPTER 31 - VETERAN READINESS & EMPLOYMENT (VR&E)

A benefit for veterans with service-related disabilities. Tuition and mandatory fees are paid directly to the school. Books and supplies are paid to the bookstore. Subsistence allowance is paid directly to student monthly.



The student must submit a Veteran Student Clearance form to the SCO (a CNU-created authorization form). The SCO will certify the student's enrollment through the VA website, Enrollment Manager.

The SCO will update student's record in CNU's internal system to reflect the use of VA Educational Benefits, the type, and the certification date.

ALL changes to credit hours must be reported to the VA through Enrollment Manager.

The student will be paid an allowance directly. Any questions or concerns they have regarding their benefit will be managed by their assigned VRC.
